SUBJECT: Environmental Policy Statement

1. The Delaware Air National Guard and the 166th Airlift Wing believes protecting the environment is one of our highest priorities and is a major factor in our decision making. The Delaware Air National Guard is dedicated to continued improvement of our processes to prevent and reduce waste generation. The Wing will maintain compliance with federal, state and local environmental laws and regulations, as well as executive orders and U.S. Air Force instructions and guidance.

The Delaware Air National Guard and the 166th AW activities include operation and maintenance of C-130H cargo aircraft with the support of corrosion control, aerospace ground equipment, vehicle and aircraft maintenance, administrative functions, and facilities maintenance.  - f. Work in partnership with all stakeholders to promote waste reduction.
